Make a List

- Check Canvas Often (at least weekly)
 - Determine if it's Major, Minor, Other
 - Plan out Major/Minor assignment
 - Break task into smaller parts
 - Plan which days to accomplish each part
 - Map out daily tasks
 - Make a list
 - Must do (3 or 4) vs what can wait (add to calendar)
 - Set timed expectations for each task
 - Is it working?





Use a calendar

- Printed Calendar/Planner
 - Daily assignments
 - Fun design
- Canvas Calendar
 - Many teachers use
 - Students can add their own items
 - See all classes in one place
 - Color-code classes
- Cell Phone Calendar
 - TickTick
 - Google Keep
- Whatever they choose, help them figure out how to use it
 - Sit down with them to map assignments out
 - Follow up-check in to see how it's working
 - Modify/Change if it's not effective

- Read a chapter (or worksheet, packet, lab) and take notes


 - Jot down key words/phrases

- Using a highlighter don't highlight everything!
